COVID-19 Policy for Indoor & Outdoor Gatherings

As of 5/9/22

RATIONALE:

- The Allegheny Conference is committed to the Pittsburgh region, committed to supporting our region's employers, and committed to convening our membership to move the region forward <u>all in the safest</u> <u>way possible.</u>
- The underlying premise of the work that we do is to create a vital, globally competitive region for all.
 Consistent with our mission, it is important to remember that now, more than ever, advancing what we do to grow and improve our region is critical.
- Our recommended policy is consistent with other indoor and outdoor gathering policies in our region.
- The Conference will continue to monitor local, state and national guidelines, including CDC guidelines, and update this policy as circumstances dictate.

INDOOR/OUTDOOR GATHERING POLICY

(No admittance into the event without proof of vaccination or a negative COVID19 test)

- This policy applies to gatherings of 50 or more people that involve external parties.
- According to CDC guidelines in Allegheny County the community COVID level is low. Per Allegheny Conference Indoor/Outdoor gathering policy, masks will no longer be required if:
 - Attendees provide proof of full vaccination, (hard copy or digital) or
 - o Provide results of a negative COVID 19 test (hard copy or digital) taken within 48-hours of the gathering. *Unless dictated otherwise by the event venue*.
 - ✓ Fully vaccinated against COVID-19, means it has been at least two weeks since receiving the second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine or the single dose of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.
- People may choose to wear a mask at any time.
- People with symptoms or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should stay home and/or wear a mask.
- Social distancing is encouraged.
- When possible, we will continue to offer virtual or hybrid options for events.
